In some cases, a nerve block catheter may be used to provide continuous or extended pain relief. This allows local anaesthetic to be delivered over time, maintaining comfort following the procedure and reducing the need for additional medication.

- ✓ Probe cover, 13cm x 150cm, with gel, tape and elastic bands
- ✓ Clear Fenestrated Drape 70 X 60cm
- ✓ Tray, 13cm x 19.5cm x 3cm, with two gallipots
- ✓ Wrap
